The Web Design category award will be given to students who have produced a Web site that meets the following criteria:

- The Web site must be created, written, and designed entirely by students.
- The Web site must be developed either as part of a class (curricular) or as part of an extracurricular activity supervised by a teacher.
- If the Web site is a web version of an established publication (school newspaper, yearbook, etc.), it **must** demonstrate principles of creative and professional web design and be more than just an online copy of the original publication (e.g., cannot simply be a PDF version of a newspaper or other publication).
- The Web site must have a minimum of three separate web pages (for example, a main page plus at least two links to other pages also designed by the students).
- The Web site must have appeared online or have been substantially updated after August 2007.
